The contract provides for the replacement of the entire ultrasound equipment in all departments over the next eight years. Siemens Healthineers is responsible for the supply, installation, training and service of the 29 new systems. The hospital benefits from a homogeneous range of equipment with uniform operating concepts. This is intended to ensure high-quality patient care as well as efficient medical operations. The contract term of the technology partnership is at least eight years with an option to extend it for two years.

This gives us state-of-the-art ultrasound systems in various technical designs.
